### MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Second Sunday of Easter is considered the octave or 8th day of Easter. For the major feasts such as Easter and Christmas the Church celebrates the feast for 8 days. These celebrations are just too important to be celebrated on only one day. The first day of Easter was Easter Sunday; the eighth day of Easter is the Second Sunday of Easter. In the year 2000 Pope John Paul II (who is being canonized today along with Pope John XXIII) declared this to be Divine Mercy Sunday. The Gospel for today is about the gift of the power to forgive sins being given to the Church. This day is about rejoicing in the mercy of God made tangible in the Church especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Observing the Feast of Divine Mercy comes with some Indulgences. A plenary indulgence (the forgiveness of all temporal punishment resulting from sins that have already been confessed) is granted on the Feast of Divine Mercy if to all the faithful who go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and "in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. 'Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!')." A partial indulgence (the remission of some temporal punishment from sin) is granted to the faithful "who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation.

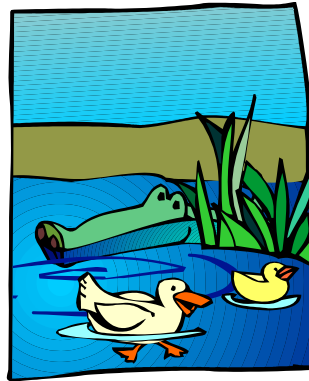
