## MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR EUCHARISTIC PRAYERS VI

After the words of Institution comes the "Mystery of Faith". The old translation had the priest begin with "Let us proclaim the Mystery of Faith." The weakness of this translation is that it suggested that the mystery of the Eucharist was in the acclamation. It seemed to put the definition ahead of the reality. In the new translation the words of the priest "The Mystery of Faith" are meant as an acclamation of awe at the mystery of the bread and wine having become the Body and Blood of Christ. The assembly joins with its own acclamation of awe using one of the three acclamations presented.

Two of the acclamations are based on St. Paul's words to the Corinthians: "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" (1 Cor. 11:26) The other acclamation which proclaims the saving power of Christ's death and resurrection has its source in John's gospel. After Jesus encounters the woman at the well, she proclaims her wonder at the Person of Jesus to her fellow Samaritans in the village. After they meet Jesus they announce "We know that this is indeed the Savior of the world: (John 4:42)

Ideally the Memorial Acclamation would be sung to more fully express our witness at this wonder of our faith. Through this acclamation we join Christ and His Church in announcing the central truth of our faith to have our hearts lifted up and be divinized by this mystery.
