There is a feeling of a certain degree of being powerless begin dependent on the kindness of others. It occurs to me that this is the message of Christianity that is hard to learn... St. Paul in 2 Corinthians speaks of experiencing God saying to him "My grace is enough for you for my power is made perfect in weakness." Paul goes on to say that he will boast of his weakness for then the power of Christ lives in him. It is in his weakness that he is strong.. I have to admit that this is a hard lesson to learn. This is a difficult lesson to learn. Rather than boasting about depending on others for transportation and finding it difficult to read, I would much rather be the strong person. This seems to be God's lesson for me at this time. I ask for your prayers for me at this time that I may be open to the message that God is giving to me and may learn to see the power of Christ acting through me as St. Paul was able to do in his weakness.

## Blessings in a Backpack Program

### Micah Mission

**Thank you!!** People from the May-Port CG communities have been generous in giving over \$9,000 to provide food to our local children who are food insecure.

- **35 backpacks of food** were sent home weekly with Peter Boe Jr. elementary students
- **3-4 volunteers** transported the backpacks from May-Port Food Pantry to the elementary school each week
- **600+ backpacks** were distributed the spring of 2014

**Looking ahead...**we are expanding the backpack program to May-Port CG Middle School where the school officials believe there may be an even greater need. With that expansion, the number of backpacks distributed each week may go up to 70. In the fall, the cost of each backpack will go up to at least \$5. This means that we will need at **least \$350 per week** and **\$13,300 for the 2014-2015 school year.**
