MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR TRINITY

Today we celebrate both the simplest and the most complex mystery of our Faith. It simplicity is expressed most clearly in John 3:16: "God so loved the world that he gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." God is love. He expresses His love in the Son. The effect of that love is eternal life, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. The simplicity is already getting complex. The simplicity is God loves the world. God gives His Son. Those who believe have eternal life. The simpler something is the harder it is to describe. God is as simple as it gets: He is one, His is love. When we ask what it means that He is one and that He is love, suddenly we are in a realm difficult to understand. If God is fully one, He would seem to be self-contained. He does not need creation, it serves no real purpose. God is love, He pours Himself out in an ever evolving Creation, through His Word and the Spirit of life. There cannot be three gods, only one can be truly supreme. It truly is a mystery, God needs nothing for He is one but He has chosen from before time to love. So he reveals Himself as one who loves, the Gather; the one who is loved, the Son; and love itself the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is a mystery a person can get lost it if you are philosophically inclined; but it is a very simple message God loves us so much that He game us His Son so that might share in His life.
