### MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR CONFIRMATION

Next week on June 6 Our Lady of Peace will be hosting the conferral of the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist on the children of Our Lady of Peace, as well as the parishes in Larimore, Reynolds/Thompson and Hillsboro/Argusville by Bishop John Folda. Since we are hosting, I thought it might be appropriate to reflect on the meaning of Confirmation. A common misperception has been that Confirmation was like graduation for the Church or that somehow this sacrament made adults out of children. Actually Confirmation is one of the Initiation sacraments along with Baptism and First Eucharist. Through Baptism a person enters into the Death and Resurrection of Christ. When someone is baptized, that person is transformed from being a sinful creature (ending in earthly death) into being an adopted child of God (beginning the journey into the fullness of eternal life). When Jesus was facing His death on the Cross, He told the disciples that it was necessary that He leave in order that the Father might send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is God's fullness of life being poured into believers forming them into a People of God, the Body of Christ. By the power of the Holy Spirit this community re-enacts the sacrifice of Jesus so that we might be nourished with His Body and Blood in communion. Through Confirmation the Christian is gifted with the power of the Holy Spirit to say yes to God and carry out the command Christ gave us, to love one another as He has loved us.

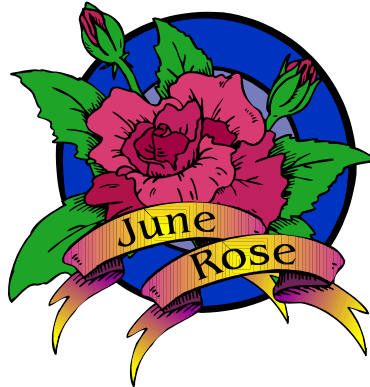
