MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

CORPUS CHRISTI

Today is the feast of Corpus Christi or the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This feast grew out of the institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday. There was a desire to have a more joyful context in which to honor the Eucharist. In countries where this feast is a Holy Day of Obligation, this feast is celebrated on the Thursday after Most Holy Trinity Sunday. Where it is not a Holy Day, it is celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday. Traditionally there was a procession with stops at four stations. At each station there would be hymns and prayers along with a blessing with the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance. The focus of this feast is to celebrate the gift of the Real Presence. We celebrate our faith that the bread and wine after consecration has become the Body and Blood of Christ. The theme of the processions is the joy that God is present with us sacramentally, even if He is no longer physically visible. We are invited to rejoice that God is truly present with us.

WHY GO TO CHURCH

A Church attendee wrote a letter to the editor of a newspaper and complained that it made no sense to go to church every Sunday.
