MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

As I noted last week there are four Eucharistic Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions. The first of these Prayers is entitled "The Church on the Path of Unity". This Prayer celebrates that the Gospel of Christ brings together people from many languages and nations and forms

them into one family. In this prayer we ask God to strengthen the bonds of unity among His faithful symbolized locally by the bishop, in the world by the Pope and the whole order of Bishops united with the Pope.

The second Prayer is called "The Church on the Way to Salvation". This Prayer identifies the Church as the new Israel wandering in the desert seeking our homeland. For the people of Israel that homeland was the land across the Jordan. It took them forty years of wandering through the desert before they were prepared to enter their homeland. We as members of the Church are led by the Holy Spirit through this life toward the eternal kingdom of God. For us it takes a lifetime before we are prepared to join the Church in the kingdom of God.

The third Prayer, "Jesus the Way to the Father", gives thanks to God for sending us His Word as the path to salvation. He is the Word through whom the worlds were created. This Word became flesh and through His words calls us to follow Him to the Father. By the Blood of His cross and sealed by the Holy Spirit we joined into one family. As one family we ask God to move us to be attentive to the signs of the times and devote ourselves to the service of the gospel. We pray that we might be attentive to the needs of all and by sharing both their grief and their joy we might bring them the good news of salvation.

The fourth Prayer, "Jesus Who Went About Doing Good", celebrates Jesus special ministry to children, the poor, the sick and sinners, the oppressed and the afflicted. In His ministry He announced the care of the Father for all. We pray that through Jesus our eyes will be opened to the needs of our brothers and sisters and be a comfort to those who labor and are burdened. We pray that the Church will be a living witness to truth, freedom, peace and justice, so that all people may be raised up to a new hope.
