MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

EUCCHARISTIC PRAYERS IV

There are several common elements in every Eucharistic Prayer. There are the Prefaces, some of which are can vary when used with Prayers I, II or III. The other Eucharistic Prayers have specific Prefaces attached to them as part of the focus of the specific Prayer.

Every prayer has an *epiclesis*, which is an invocation that the Father send down the Holy Spirit so that the gifts of bread and wine will be changed into the body and blood of Christ. Accompanying this prayer is the gesture of the priest stretching his hands over the gifts of bread and wine. This is a type of laying on of hands similar to Confirmation and Holy Orders when the Father is also asked to send down His Holy Spirit. The words of the epiclesis have their source in the Jewish table prayers when the blessing of the cup included a supplication that God send the Messiah to Israel and restore the Davidic kingdom. There is after the words of consecration a secondary epiclesis in which the priest prays that this Eucharist will draw all that receive into a greater communion.
