MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

FAMILY AND MARRIAGE: Intimate Partnership

In marriage a man and a woman establish an intimate partnership of life and love. As a partnership both parties come together to form a special community of two. Being a partnership both parties must provide to the other the room to share their most intimate lives with each other. Intimacy involves revealing to the other who one is. This revelation includes one's emotional, spiritual and physical life. To be truly intimate to the point of establishing a true partnership requires trust and risk. Revealing our values, our hopes, our dreams to another puts us at a vulnerable position. The more open and revealing one is to another the greater the risk of rejection. Two people, who know each other well, will know the weak spots in each other's ego. They will know how to wound each other emotionally or spiritually.

Because we instinctively know this, trust is required to take this risk. Trust is not easily given, it has to grow and develop. Because trust has to be nurtured, it will require both parties to work at being both open to what the other reveals as well as willing to share oneself with the other. It is in the context of trust and openness that love can grow. Sometimes love is confused with attraction. It often starts with attraction but it cannot develop unless both parties know that the other is committed to them. Love would be more accurately described as a decision to give one's life to another. Love involves the willingness to sacrifice oneself for the benefit of the other.

Marriage is the partnership of the whole life and love. When two people consent to marriage, they are committing themselves completely to each other. Each is promising to put the spouse first in his or her life. Every interest and relationship must be at the service of the marital relationship. Friendships, hobbies and work interests will be important, but must be secondary to the partnership of marriage. Ultimately, each person tries to provide an image of God's love to each other.
