MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

FAMILY AND MARRIAGE: God's Plan

Matrimony is a unique institution. Genesis seems to teach in the two Creation stories God always intended Marriage to be an intimate partnership between a man and a woman. In the first story God chooses to create humanity in His image. The verse goes on to emphasize that it is as male and female that humanity is a true image of God. The second story of Creation is the Garden of Eden. God creates the human by forming him out of clay and breathing life into the human. God then recognizes that it is not good for the human to be alone and needs to find a suitable partner. God forms the animals out of the clay and presents them to the human. He names them establishing a relationship with them but none of them are suitable to be a partner. Then God takes one of the ribs of the human and builds it up into a woman. The man recognizes the woman as bone of his bone and flesh of his flesh expressing the full equality and connectedness between man and woman. Scripture emphasizes that a deep unity between man and woman are God's intention for matrimony. Despite this apparent intention the scriptures recognize that as a result of Original Sin even marriage is wounded. This wound can be characterized by a spirit of domination, infidelity, jealousy, and conflict which can escalate into hatred and separation. The Catholic Catechism of the Church notes that the understanding of marriage develops under the guidance of the Law in the Old Testament. Although the patriarchs are reported to have been involved in polygamy, the teaching provided by Moses emphasizes protection of the wife from arbitrary domination by the husband. The prophets begin to describe the covenant between God and Israel in terms of a marriage. Images of God's remaining committed to His people despite moments of infidelity. In the gospel Jesus affirms this image of permanent commitment as a sign of God's commitment to us. Jesus raises marriage between believers to the level of being a sacrament. As a sacrament God is sharing His very presence to marriage to give to those willing to accept His love the power to form a union that cannot be dissolved. Marriage is about provide a stable relationship in which two people can grow into ever deeper intimacy and children can become the full human persons God intends each of them to be. Marriage by being a symbol of God's union with His people has the grace of forming a man and a woman into one flesh. The grace of matrimony does require a response from the partners. They are called to forgiveness, forbearance, kindness and ultimately to love each other even when it may seem most difficult.

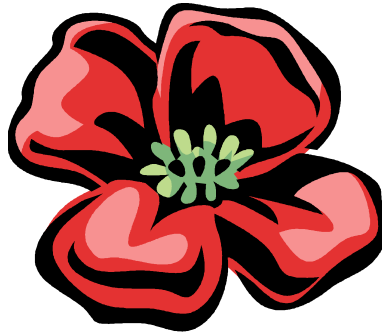
