## MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

### Martyrs In Our Times

As I was preparing for Mass last Wednesday I noticed the saint of the day was Christopher Magallanes and companions. Not being familiar with that name I looked it up. Father Magallanes was one of twenty-one priests and lay people killed for their faith in Mexico between 1915 and 1937. Mexico at that time was actively anti [Catholic. Father Magallanes was targeted because he had established seminaries to train priests to serve the Catholic population in the midst of the persecution. This caught my attention as we tend to think of martyrs and persecutions in the early Church. Here was a persecution that took place in a neighboring country less than a century ago. The famous author, Graham Greene, wrote a good novel about this persecution. Called the Power and the Glory it describes a "whiskey" priest. It describes a priest who has his flaws but still risks his life to minister to his people.
