While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them.

With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him...Luke 24:30-31

A consistent feature of the resurrection stories is that the risen Jesus is not immediately recognizable. Something had to happen to reveal that it was Jesus right there with them.

I think this keeps happening. Recently for me it was in a hospital after surgery. Far greater than my apprehension about the surgery was my fear of struggling with post-op nausea and pain in a room with someone who kept the TV blaring on some violent program or scathing talk show. I'd been with family trapped like that.

Wheeled in from the recovery area, I discovered I had my own room with warm yellow walls—the color of my room in the home where I raised my children long ago. The floor was the same terrazzo pattern as the kitchen in that house! In that moment I recognized that Jesus was saying, "I am right here. You are home."
